

Canal Dock Equipment Storage Program

Anyone who lives in New Haven or the Greater New Haven Area can join Canal Dock and pay for storage of canoes, kayaks, paddleboards and rowing shells on a space available basis.

Canoe (1-person) - \$200/year

Canoe (2-person) - \$225/year

Kayak (single) - \$200/year

Kayak (double) - \$225/year

Paddle Board - \$200/year

Rowing shell (1x) - \$500/year

Rowing shell (2x) - \$600/year

Rowing shell (4+) - \$700/year

Rowing shell (8+) - \$1000/year

Special Craft - TBD

- Anyone wishing to store equipment in Canal Dock boathouse must first become a "Basic" member (\$100)
- Equipment stored is "At Your Own Risk," i.e. Canal Dock is not responsible for loss or damage of privately owned equipment stored in the boathouse
- COI (Certificate of Insurance) must be presented that names Canal Dock Boathouse, Inc. as an additional insured with a minimum \$300,000 limit of liability
- Canoes, kayaks and paddle boards must be stored "on end," that is, standing upright; rowing shells must be stored in racks provided by Canal Dock
- Canoes, kayaks, paddle boards and rowing shells should be locked; Canal Dock is not responsible for theft of your equipment
- Paddles, life jackets and other related equipment should not be stored in the boathouse (Canal Dock is not responsible for loss or theft of personal equipment.)
- Paying for equipment storage does not include unrestricted access to the facility; i.e. personal equipment can be accessed during normal hours of operation (weekly schedule & hours are currently being planned) and access can be restricted when special events take place
- Canal Dock will designate storage areas and/or racks for all privately owned vessels and reserves the right to change the storage area or storage rack at its discretion
- Life jackets must be worn at all times when on the water
- Rowing outings require a minimum of four oars (or two boats) on the water
- Canal Dock staff will monitor foul weather for high winds and rough water; when appropriate, on-water activities can be cancelled or restricted to insure the safety of members
- Water and air temperature restrictions will be monitored and controlled by Canal Dock staff and coaches
- The availability of storage space isn't guaranteed and can be cancelled on 30 days notice
- Prices may increase at any time at the discretion of the Canal Dock Board of Directors

Canal Dock Boathouse, Inc. (“Canal Dock”) Boat Storage Application
